Charter for the Social Committee

The purpose of this charter is to define the mission, membership, authority and responsibilities for the Ironstone HOA Social Committee.

Mission

The Social Committee's purpose is to promote community spirit and boost socialization.

The Committee will present ideas to the board for activities and events to engage and interact with members of our community in a welcoming and inclusive manner. The committee is encouraged to create a wide range of social events to reach adults, children and the entire community.

This will be achieved by meeting as often as necessary to plan, promote and carry out neighborhood social events throughout the year.

Membership

The board will appoint the committee chair and co-chair. The committee shall have a minimum of two (2) members and a maximum of five (5) members, including at least one (1) who is currently serving on the HOA Board. The board may fill vacancies on the committee and may remove a member from the committee at any time without cause.

Committee members commit to meeting at least two (2) times per year, and commit to a term of at least one year.

Members must be in good standing, i.e. assessments current, no outstanding CC&R and/or rules non-compliance issues, and current and continuing owners.

This is a volunteer position and no members will be compensated in any way.

Responsibilities

- Facilitate event planning
- Promote interest in social events via appropriate channels (i.e. facebook, printed information, community board signage, etc.)
- Collect any funds from the event if necessary

- Make appropriate reservations as needed (i.e. food trucks, inflatable rentals, etc.)
- Submit minutes and/or reports of meetings to the Board
